





# RHYTHM

A strong, regular, repeated pattern of movement.



A Network Leader meets with their Network once a month.



A Network Leader meets 1:1 regularly with those in their Network.



A Network Leader meets 1:1 regularly with an Apprentice Network Leader.



A Network Leaders meets 1:1 and/or huddles every 6-8 weeks with their Movement Leader.

#### RELATIONAL RHYTHM #5

Networks & Movements gather together 3-4x a year in order to plant churches together.



# THINGS TO CONSIDER IN A NETWORK LEADER APPRENTICE

- 1. Do they have a leadership pipeline that provides a vision for prospective leaders?
- 2. Do they insist on apprenticeship at every level?
- 3. Do they have a regular gathering for leaders and apprentice leaders to receive vision and training in reproducing?

# STEPS TO APPRENTICE A NETWORK LEADER

- 1. I Do. You Watch. We Talk.
- 2. I Do. You Help. We Talk.
- 3. You Do. I Help. We Talk.
- 4. You Do. I Watch. We Talk.
- You Do. Someone else watches.

## THE 4RS OF NEWTHING

R	Relationship	<ul> <li>Committed to being friends on mission.</li> </ul>
R	Reproducing	Committed to reproducing at all levels.
R	Residency	<ul> <li>Committed to investing in the next generation of leaders and church planters.</li> </ul>
R	Resources	Committed to sharing our resources to achieve more together.

### NETWORKS BUILT ON COMMITMENTS

**RELATIONSHIP COMMITMENT:** Each NewThing church commits to engaging in their local network (4-6 reproducing churches) for the monthly meetings and discussions on how to reproduce together.

**REPRODUCING COMMITMENT:** Each NewThing church commits to flling out and MRP (My Reproducing Plan) every year. The MRP is a plan for reproduction that covers the next 12 months.

**RESIDENCY COMMITMENT:** Each NewThing church commits to having and training one church planting resident per year.

**RESOURCE COMMITMENT:** Each NewThing church commits to completing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and paying into their local network.

### MORE THAN BBQ

Step 1: Pray for your city.

Step 2: Dream big.

Step 3: Find others who share your dream.

Step 4: Plant one church as a group—but plant it well.

Step 5: Start gathering and coaching church planters.

Step 6: Share your specific vision for the city.

Step 7: invite them into the vision.

Step 8: Pool resources.

Step 9: Give birth to another network.

Step 10: Give God all the credit.
